Mr. Niebres would like to be issued a liquor license for the new license year, beginning July 1, 2010. Mr. Niebres addressed the Commission and stated that he would possibly like to have a piano player for entertainment. They will be open for lunch and dinner, Sunday through Saturday, and their hours of operation will be consistent with the hours of liquor service operation under the Liquor Code. They will have a functioning bar. Mr. Niebres formerly leased restaurant space on the upper floor of the Bandito Barney’s building. He stated they he was still working with the Kane County Health Department on some minor issues.
