Also in attendance are Police Chief Terry Mee, Village Attorney Pat O'Connor and Village Clerk Jennifer Rehberg.

2.1 Approval of the September 20, 2010, Regular Meeting Minutes

4.1 License Violation Hearing (Sale to Underage Persons – attachment) – Family Buffet

Chief Mee read the violation into record. The police department performed a Liquor License Compliance Inspection and two minors were served alcohol in the restaurant. Mr. Sanchez, the owner, pleads guilty to the charges. The employee was served a citation and was fined \$250 and given 30 days of supervision. Mr. Sanchez addressed the board and stated he has spoken to his employees, attended training and apologized for the mistake. Bartels asked if this was the first violation. Mee stated it was the first violation.

Trustee Ruffulo stated the Commission agreed to fine Family Buffet \$1,000 with 45 days to pay.

**4.2 Alpine Room/Polar Dome Expanded Liquor Service and/or New License Classification
Request Presentations (Tony Borrico)**

Mee stated the licensee is in attendance. Mr. Borrico is looking to extend the service of the restaurant to the east of the existing restaurant area. Mr. Borrico addressed the Board. He would like it to be a mini-Sears Center. He has already held four concerts. He is requesting a license enabling the attendees to take alcoholic beverages to their seats. The seating capacity is 2,500 to 3,000. Chief Mee explained that this would be a new license that does not exist now. Mr. Borrico explained his plans for the arena and the different events he would like to host. He had an event with 150 to 200 people in attendance. President Bartels stated the Fire Department should be asked to look at the facility again just to make sure it is appropriate. Mr. Borrico suggested a walk through by the commission. Bartels suggests this be on the agenda for the next Committee of the Whole Meeting for discussion.

River Lee's, Diamond Jim's & Fernando's)**




5.0 Adjournment
