1. Certificate of Appropriateness for Main Street Dental Signage: 106 N. River Street

He said this technically is not allowed in the historic district but that can be determined by the Commission. The applicant, Dr. Amish Desai, presented the charcoal awning color to the Commission. Shock commented that he would like the awning to be black to match the restaurant awning at the next building. Chairman Brewer recommended that the immediate neighboring unit have the same awning color as the dental unit has. Dr. Desai advised that he owns the unit immediately next door and that he plans to match the awning color at both of his units.
