4.1 Presentation on Signage Legislation Change Request – East Dundee Citgo (B-4 Licence)

Chief Mee introduced Jeff Glogovsky, the Manager of the East Dundee Citgo, and noted he brought to Citgo's attention signage deviations on their building. Chief Mee mentioned the B-4 License states that specific branding and pricing of products on exterior and fixed signs is prohibited. Citgo has a menu board on the building and an LED board to advertise products. They would like to be able to advertise the prices of the beer and wine and feel carrying the products is useless unless they can do so. Glogovsky noted that other gas stations in close vicinity are able to advertise their products and feels that everyone needs to be in the same playing field. President Bartels asked Chief Mee if he would put together new wordage needed to modify the current ordinance and report back to the Commission.
