### **3.0 Old Business**

3.1 Class F Special Events License Request – Family Buffet in Conjunction with Sterling Bay (Santa's Village Property Owner) for Rodeo Events on Santa's Village Property (October 3, 17 & 31, 2009)

Chief Mee noted the Village Attorney (Pat O'Connor) is comfortable with a segregated dispensing area, in this case a tent. He noted it is the responsibility of the police department and the event coordinators to maintain security. In the packet it lists a diagram of where the liquor tent will be located. The Class F covers the 3 days of the rodeos (October 3, 17 and 31). Chief Mee stated Family Buffet is the requester in conjunction with Sterling Bay and the rodeo company. He noted the insurance certificate covers the requirements under the ordinance and the paperwork is compliant. Village Attorney Russ Hartigan's concern was to make sure there is security so no one leaves the area with alcohol. It was noted that there will be security at entrance and exit and there will be a periodic police presence to make sure this does not happen. Chief Mee noted there may be complete police presence depending on the number of attendees. Attorney Hartigan stated there was a similar event in LaGrange and the only problem they had was people were taking liquor out into the parking lot. Trustee Cichowski's only concern is overindulgence of alcohol. Trustee VanOstenbridge asked how many people are expected to attend the rodeo. Chuck Black noted they expect up to 600 people. Cichowski asked the process of purchasing beer. Chuck Black explained how the wrist band limits each participant to 3 beers total. Cichowski asked if they can buy 3 beers at one time. Black said no, they can only buy one beer at a time. Chief Mee noted this is a different use of Santa's Village property but it isn't any different than any other special event held in the Village. He stated there is a \$100 per day fee for each Class F event. Once they receive the \$300 they will issue the license.
