

ORDINANCE NUMBER 10 - 08

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ABATEMENT OF A PORTION OF
THE TAXES HERETOFORE LEVIED FOR CORPORATE
PURPOSES AND SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
COMMENCING MAY 1, 2009 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2010 FOR
THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE AND COOK COUNTIES,
ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Counties of Kane and Cook, State of Illinois, did, on the 7th day of December, 2009, pass a certain ordinance, to-wit: Ordinance No. 09-37, entitled: .

ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES AND SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MAY 1, 2009, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2010, FOR THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE AND COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

which ordinance was duly approved by the Village President of the Village of East Dundee on December 7, 2009 (hereinafter "Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance authorizes and directs the County Clerk to levy an amount of money for corporate purposes and special funds for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010 for the Village; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Village that a certain portion of the taxes heretofore levied for corporate purposes and special funds be abated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Abatement of Tax. The taxes in the amount of Twenty Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$26,856.00) heretofore levied for the fiscal year commencing

May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010 in the Ordinance for police salaries, account number 01-21-5010, is hereby abated. All remaining portions of the taxes levied for the aforementioned fiscal year will remain in effect. The taxes levied following this abatement will now total Five Hundred Forty Six Thousand Four Hundred Forty Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$546,444.00).

Section Two. Filing of Ordinance. Upon adoption of this Ordinance, the Village Clerk shall file a certified copy hereof with the Clerk of Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, and it shall be the duty of said County Clerk to abate said tax levied for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010 in accordance with the provisions above.

Section Three. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Village Board and signing and approval by the Village President.

Section Four. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Five. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Six. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


