

**ORDINANCE NO. 02 - 01**

**ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE  
REGULATIONS OF THE AMENDED KANE COUNTY STORM  
WATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE 00-312**

**WHEREAS**, the Kane County Storm Water Management Committee and its Technical Advisory Committee drafted a comprehensive countywide storm water management ordinance and amendments thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Board of Kane County, after public hearings, passed the Kane County Storm Water Management Ordinance 00-312 on November 14, 2000, and further amended said ordinance by Ordinance No. 01-337 on October 9, 2001, and by Ordinance No. 01-442 on December 11, 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Illinois, have examined the Kane County Storm Water Management Ordinance 00-312 and amendments thereto and find it in the best interests of the Village to adopt its regulations by reference;

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Illinois, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-1062(k) adopted the Kane County Storm Water Management Ordinance by reference pursuant to Ordinance 01-11, and desire to adopt the proposed amendments to the storm water management ordinance consistent with Kane County's amended ordinance and plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section One. Regulations Adopted. That the amended regulations of the Kane County Storm Water Management Ordinance 00-312 adopted by the Kane County Board on November 14, 2000, and amendments thereto adopted on October 9, 2001, as Ordinance No. 01-337, and Ordinance No. 01-442 on December 11, 2001, and specifically those relating to Article 15 therein be and they are hereby adopted by reference as the Village Storm Water Standards (hereafter the "Storm Water Ordinance") as criteria for issuing storm water management permits as the minimum engineering standards for storm water management of the Village in reviewing and approving development under all development approval authorized by law and Village ordinances and standards,

at least one copy of said Kane County Storm Water Management Ordinance being on file in the office of the Village Clerk, which ordinance has been on file with the Village Clerk for a period of 30 days before the adoption of this ordinance and shall be kept in said office available for public use, inspection, and examination continuously.

Section Two. Administration. The Village Administrator and/or his designee is designated to administer and enforce this ordinance and specifically to enforce the provisions of Article 15 therein and the Village hereby requests that the County certify the Village to administer and enforce Article 15 within its corporate limits, including both Kane and Cook Counties, Illinois.

Section Three. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as provided by law.

Section Four. Severability. If any section, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Five. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Six. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
