

ORDINANCE NUMBER 07 - 19

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE V, PUBLIC WORKS,
CHAPTER 51, WATER, SECTION 51.38, BILLING PROVISIONS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that **Title V, Public Works, Chapter 51, Water, Section 51.38, Billing Provisions**, be amended.

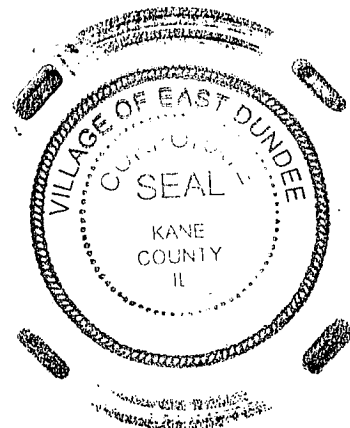
NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That **Title V, Public Works, Chapter 51, Water, Section 51.38, Billing Provisions** of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

' 51.38 BILLING PROVISIONS.

(F)(2) The notices shall be as follows:

(a) *Notice of collection letter.*



Dear Customer,

Our records show payment on water and/or sewer bill due 21 days ago has not yet been received. You may have overlooked this matter. Unless full payment is received within 14 days, you will receive a post card in the mail requesting payment within 5 days. If your payment is not received within 5 days, your service will be disconnected, no further notice may be made. You may request a hearing with the Director of Public Works to dispute this bill within the next 14 days as set forth in ' 51.42 of the Village Code of Ordinances.

There will be a (fee established in the annual fee schedule) re-connection fee added onto your past due balance that must be paid before service will be restored.

If our correspondence has crossed in the mail, please disregard this letter.

1. In the event that the charge remains unpaid on the fifteenth day after the date of the aforesaid notice, the following notice shall be mailed ordinary to the owner of the premises, occupant and user of the service.

(a) *Notice of termination.*

You are hereby notified that there has been no response to the notice of delinquency in the payment of the water charges and the 14-day period therein stated has lapsed. You are hereby notified that on (insert date 7 days after service of this notice) the village will physically disconnect the service to which it is connected and will declare the building located at (insert address) as **Aunfit** for human occupancy.@

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict

herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
