

Ordinance No. 14-25

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS
AMENDING THE NUMBER OF CLASS C LIQUOR LICENSES
(Immanuel Lutheran Church)**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, Article IV of the Liquor Control Act (235 ILCS 5/4-1) authorizes the Village to determine the number, kind and classification of licenses for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor; and,

WHEREAS, Immanuel Lutheran Church has requested a Class C liquor license for its Heritage Fest related event and the Village President as the Local Liquor Control Commissioner has tentatively approved the request subject to the creation of an additional Class C license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Cook and Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the Code of the Village of East Dundee, as amended, be and is hereby amended by adding to the list of authorized licenses in Section 116.05(B) the following:

Classification	Number Permitted
"C"	2"

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
