**ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE XI, BUSINESS REGULATIONS,
CHAPTER 116, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, SECTION 116.05(H)
TO BE REPLACED WITH A NEW TITLE XI, BUSINESS
REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 116, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES,
SECTION 116.05(H)**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that Title XI, **Business Regulations**, Chapter 116, **Alcoholic Beverages**, Section 116.05(H), be repealed to be replaced with a new Section 116.05(H).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That **Title XI, Business Regulations, Chapter 116, Alcoholic Beverages**, Section 116.04(H) of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed effective immediately and replaced with a new Section 116.04(H) as follows:

§ 116.05 LICENSES

. . .

(H) Liquor licenses issued on July 1 of each year and the fees for licenses issued shall be prorated based for issue date, determined as follows:

- (a) July 1-Sept. 30: fee to be prorated 100%
- (b) Oct. 1-Dec. 31: fee to be prorated 75%

(c) Jan. 1-March 31: fee to be prorated 50%

(d) April 1-June 30: fee to be prorated 25%

Licenses, regardless of issue date, will expire June 30 of each year.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
