

RESOLUTION NUMBER 12 - 10

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF THE LOMA REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM IN THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, at the Village Special Board Meeting on September 14, 2009 the Village Board Authorized for the expenditure of funds to assist property owners in filing of action requests with FEMA in light of recent issued flood plain map revisions; and

WHEREAS, approximately 54 residents completed a survey to remove their home from the flood plain area and submitted an application to the Village for the \$100 LOMA reimbursement, to date, at least 24 residents were able to successfully remove their parcel from the flood plain; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village to end the LOMA reimbursement program on February 28, 2010. After this time, the Village will no longer be accepting applications for reimbursement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the Village of East Dundee hereby authorizes the termination of the LOMA reimbursement program.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section Three. Repeal. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section Four. Publication. This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
