

ORDINANCE NUMBER 03 - 16

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, ADMINISTRATION,
CHAPTER 30.06, (A), REGULAR AND SPECIAL
MEETINGS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
FOR THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee as a non-home rule unit has been granted such statutory powers pursuant to the Illinois Constitution either expressly or as may be impliedly necessary to the accomplishment of the intent of the duties expressly conferred on it by law; and

WHEREAS, WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that the meeting time for regular and special meetings be amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Title III, **Administration**, Chapter 30.06(A), **Regular and Special Meetings**, be amended to read as follows:

- (A) All regular meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be held on the first and third Monday of each month at the hour of 7:00 p.m., unless the first or third Monday of the month is a holiday, then the meeting shall fall on the following day, Tuesday. All special meetings of the Board of Trustees shall commence at 7:00 p.m. unless otherwise provided. Special meetings of the Board of Trustees may be called by the

President of the Village or by any three members of the Board. The call shall be in writing, setting forth the object of the meeting and the hour thereof, in the event a different time is desired than that as herein provided. A written or printed copy of the call shall be left at the place of residence, or place of abode, of the President and members of the Board, excepting those persons making the call, at least 24 hours prior to the meeting.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


