

ORDINANCE NUMBER 06 - 10

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, ADMINISTRATION,  
CHAPTER 31, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES,  
BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 31.16(H), DEPUTY VILLAGE CLERK

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that Title III, Administration, Chapter 31, Officers and Employees, be amended by adding a new Section 31.16(H), Deputy Village Clerk.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Title III, Administration, Chapter 31, Officers and Employees, of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new Section 31.16(H), Deputy Village Clerk as follows:

§ 31.16 VILLAGE CLERK.

- (G) *Deputy Village Clerk.* The Village Clerk may appoint one Deputy Village Clerk as necessary to discharge the functions and duties of the office of the Village Clerk. The Deputy Village Clerk is hereby permitted to perform such other acts incidental to carrying out said position.

**Section Two. Severability.** If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

**Section Three. Repeal.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

**Section Four. Publication.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
