

ORDINANCE NO. 00 - 25

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13,
GARBAGE AND REFUSE, SECTIONS 13.03 AND 13.04**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee as a non-home rule unit has been granted such statutory powers pursuant to the Illinois Constitution either expressly or as may be impliedly necessary to the accomplishment of the intent of the duties expressly conferred on it by law; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee believe that the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee and those persons who enter the territorial jurisdiction of the Village would best be served by making the following amendment to the municipal code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the Municipal Code of the Village of East Dundee, Chapter 13, **Garbage and Refuse**, Section 13.03, **Two or Less Dwelling Units**, be amended in its entirety as follows:

13.03 SIX OR LESS DWELLING UNITS. The following provisions apply only to occupied buildings containing six or less dwelling units where separate municipal water service is metered to each dwelling unit:

- (a) All waste materials, except building materials, will be collected by the garbage collector, provided, however, that no such collection shall be made unless all of the provisions of Section 13.02 and this chapter are fully complied with.
- (b) All waste materials must be placed on the parkway adjacent to a public or private street in front of the owner's premises, and must be easily accessible

to the collectors on the day of collection. On all days excepting the day of collection, containers must be stored on the owner's premises away from such parkway on such premises behind the front building line in the side yard or rear yard.

Section Two. That the Municipal Code of the Village of East Dundee, Chapter 13, **Garbage and Refuse, Section 13.04, Other Buildings or Premises**, be amended by adding the following language:

13.04 OTHER BUILDINGS OR PREMISES. The following regulations pertain to all buildings and premises other than occupied residential buildings containing six or less dwelling units as defined in Section 13.03 above:

- (a) All such buildings and premises shall be served by licensed private scavengers as often as may be required to prevent a nuisance or a threat to public health, welfare, and safety, but in no event shall such service be less than once a week.
- (b) The standards for collection shall meet all requirements of health, sanitation, and safety set by the Board of Trustees.

Section Three. Severability. If any section, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.


Section Four. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Five. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
