

RESOLUTION NUMBER 19 -07

A RESOLUTION REPEALING THE COMPETITIVE VIDEO SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN AT&T ILLINOIS AND THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee previously entered into a Competitive Video Service Agreement with AT&T Illinois to provide high-speed video service to the Village of East Dundee; and

WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has approved statewide legislation to provide high-speed video service to municipalities throughout the State of Illinois, which includes certain build-out requirements that are not part of the Competitive Video Service Agreement previously entered into by the Village of East Dundee (pursuant to S.B. 678, effective 06/30/2007); and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and desirable for the Village of East Dundee to repeal the Competitive Video Service Agreement with AT&T Illinois providing high-speed video service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the Village of East Dundee hereby repeals the Competitive Video Service Agreement between AT&T Illinois and the Village of East Dundee to provide high-speed video service to the Village of East Dundee.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section Three. Repeal. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such
