

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 11- 32**

**ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENT TO  
THE EAST DUNDEE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, American Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, has completed the 2010 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances for the Village of East Dundee, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted since the prior supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, American Legal Publishing Corporation has recommended the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or make reference to sections of the Illinois statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the Village to accept these updated sections in accordance with the changes of law of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the Village and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the Village that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One.** That the 2010 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the Village as submitted by American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, and as attached hereto be and the same is hereby adopted by reference as if set out in its entirety.

**Section Two.** Such Supplement shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and ordered to insert such supplement into the copy of the Code of Ordinances kept on file in the Office of the Clerk.

**Section Three.** This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the people of this Village and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.

**Section Seven. Severability.** If any section, paragraph or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

**Section Eight. Repeal.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

**Section Nine. Publication.** This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
