

RESOLUTION NUMBER 29-13

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE TO CHAPTER VII, PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATION, SECTION 3, THE PROMOTIONAL PROCESS, PARAGRAPH 3.4, LEADERSHIP ASSESSMENT**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee has received an amendment to the Rules and Regulations of the Police Commission approved by the Board of Police Commissioners on May 14, 2013; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rules and Regulations of the Board of Police Commissioners, Chapter I-Administration, Section 9-Amendments, the amendment was forwarded to the Village Board for hearing and approval; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee have determined that it is desirable and necessary to approve the amendment to the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Police Commissioners to Chapter VII-Promotional Examinations, Section 3-The Promotional Examination Process, paragraph 3.4- Leadership Assessment.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One.** That the Board of Trustees and the President of the Village of East Dundee hereby approve the amendment to Chapter VII-Promotional Examinations, Section 3-The Promotional Examination Process, paragraph 3.4-Leadership Assessment to henceforth read as follows:

3.4 Leadership Assessment

At the discretion of the Board, all candidates in a testing process may be submitted to an in-depth leadership assessment. If a candidate fails the leadership assessment, the candidate shall not be eligible for promotion.

**Section Two. Severability.** If any section, paragraph or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

**Section Three. Repeal.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.


