ORDINANCE NO. 71 - 6

LEVY ORDINANCE

Being an Ordinance providing for the levy and assessment of taxes for the fiscal year 1971--1972 for the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that

Section 1 A tax for the following sums of money or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, is hereby levied for the purposes specified in Appropriation Ordinance 71-3 against all taxable property in the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of May, 1971 and ending on the 30th day of April, 1972.
