

ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-18

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE,
COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS
RESTRICTING THE USE OF HOME RULE SALES TAX
AND VIDEO GAMING TAX AND LICENSE FEE REVENUES**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee ("Village") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board adopted Resolution 07-12, A Resolution Adopting Financial Policies for the Village of East Dundee, Illinois, restricting Home Rule Sales Tax collections to 1) financing for construction of water and sewer related improvements, 2) funding of the garbage collection contract, and 3) capital improvements, with emphasis on infrastructure and economic development; and

WHEREAS, the Village's Video Gaming Tax and License Fee revenue are used for the general purposes of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village ("Corporate Authorities") do hereby desire to restrict Home Rule Sales Tax revenue to the General Fund to be used for general operating purposes of the Village consistent with past practice; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities do hereby desire to restrict Video Gaming tax and license fee revenue to the Capital Improvement Fund for capital improvement purposes of the Village; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each Whereas paragraph above is incorporated by reference into this Section and made a part hereof as material and operative provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Home Rule Sales Tax revenue is hereby restricted to the General Fund to be used for general operating purposes.

SECTION 3: Video Gaming tax and license fee revenue is hereby restricted to the Capital Improvement Fund for capital improvement purposes of the Village.

SECTION 4: If any Section, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such Section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




