AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS:

WHEREAS, resurfacing contracts are about to be let by the State of Illinois for portions of Routes 63 and 72 within the corporate limits of this Village, and,

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has requested that parking of motor vehicles be regulated, as hereinafter provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1

That parking of motor vehicles will be permitted along the South edge of the curb line of Route 72 from the West corporate limits of the Village near the center of the bridge, Eastward to Van Buren Street, such parking to be only "parallel" parking, to-wit, parallel to the curbing, and only in places that are clearly marked for parking and are not prohibited therefrom by signs, driveway entrances and other prohibitions against such parking on the South side of the highway; parking of motor vehicles is hereby expressly prohibited on the North side of Route 72 from the West corporate limits near the center of the bridge Easterly to Water Street. Parallel parking shall be allowed on the North side of Route 72 from Water Street Easterly to Van Buren Street only in places clearly marked for parking, and are not prohibited therefrom by signs, driveway entrances and other prohibitions against such parking on the North side of the highway.

SECTION 2

Parking is hereby expressly prohibited and it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle on either side of the paved

USE OF STORM SEWERS


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

wastes or sanitary sewage will be drained into or permitted
to be drained into the storm water sewers and drains con-
structed by the State of Illinois and its contractors in
connection with the resurfacing of said Routes 63 and 72
through the Village of East Dundee.

ORDINANCE NO. 63 - 4

BEING AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF IMPROVEMENT
BONDS FOR THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING AND UNPAID
VOUCHERS ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH SPECIAL ASSESSMENT
NO. 91.

Whereas Special Assessment No. 91 as passed by the President and Board of Local Improvements of the Village of East Dundee was approved and confirmed by the County Court of Kane County, Illinois, on August 25, 1961, and improvement completed and a certificate of cost and completion filed in said Court by said Board of Local Improvements; and

Whereas vouchers were issued by said Board of Local Improvements for the construction of said improvements, for engineering, for legal services rendered and for certain other costs and that said vouchers are currently outstanding and unpaid, and amounting to approximately \$68,000.00; and

Whereas Ordinance No. 60-7 provided that improvement bonds be issued by said Board of Local Improvements to be exchanged for said unpaid vouchers and that the need for said bonds to issue is now demanded by the contractor who completed the construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that

Sec. 1. That the Secretary of the Board of Local Improvements of said Village be and he hereby is ordered to cause improvement bonds with interest coupons to be printed to pay all of the outstanding unpaid vouchers and interest thereon;

Sec. 2. Both interest and principal of said improvement bonds shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the office of the Treasurer of said Village at the Village Hall, in the Village of East Dundee, Illinois; said bonds shall be signed by the President of the Village, sealed with the corporate seal of said Village, and attested by the Village Clerk, and the interest coupons attached to said bonds shall be executed by facsimile signatures of said President and Village Clerk, and said officials, by their execution of said bonds, shall adopt as and for their own proper signatures their respective facsimile signatures appearing on said coupons.

Said bonds, together with interest thereon, shall be payable solely from installment payments made on said Special Assessment No. 91 and such bonds shall not in any event constitute an indebtedness of the Village of East Dundee within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory limitation.

Sec. 3. That said bonds shall be callable in numerical order beginning with Bond No. 1, shall be dated May 1, 1963, and mature December 31, 1971, shall bear interest at the rate of 6% per annum, and shall have interest coupons due annually on December 31, the first coupon (being for less than one year) shall be for \$40.00 and all coupons thereafter shall be for \$60.00.

AND SANITARY SEWER WITH SERVICE CONNECTIONS ON MADISON AVENUE IN FOX RIVER BLUFFS, UNIT NO.1, AND IN NORTHGATE MANOR SUBDIVISION IN THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, which assessment bears interest thereon are payable solely out of the installments of said assessments when collected.

THIS BOND IS ONE OF A SERIES OF BONDS WHICH ARE TO BE PAID AND REDEEMED IN NUMERICAL ORDER AND NOT ON A PRO RATA BASIS.

The bonds in said series, aggregating Sixty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$68,000.00) are numbered from 1 to 68 inclusive, all said bonds being of denomination of \$1,000.00 each.

By the terms of the statute and ordinance authorizing these bonds, whenever there shall be sufficient funds in the hands of the Treasurer of the Village of East Dundee, after payment of all interest due on said bonds, and after the establishment of such reserve, if any, as the Treasurer in his discretion may deem advisable to pay interest to become due at the next interest coupon date, to prepay one or more of said bonds, then it is the duty of such Treasurer to call and pay such bond or bonds. The Treasurer shall cause notice of such call for prepayment to be published in some newspaper of general circulation in the Village of East Dundee, Illinois, not less than five days nor more than thirty days prior to the date fixed for such prepayment. If no newspaper is published in said municipality, said notice shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in said municipality and if there be no such newspaper, such notice shall be posted in at least three prominent places within such municipality. This bond will cease to bear interest on and after the date so fixed for prepayment. The presentation of the bond will waive the necessity of giving notice of its call for prepayment. Bonds shall be paid in numerical order beginning with the lowest numbered outstanding bond.

ORDINANCE 63-5

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DEPOSIT OF HARMFUL MATERIAL
ON VILLAGE STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to deposit any material
on any street which may be harmful to the pavement thereof,
or any waste material, or any glass, or other articles
which may do injury to any person, animal or property.

SECTION 2. Coal and other materials may be deposited in
streets preparatory to delivery or use, provided that
such deposit does not reduce the usable width of the
roadway at that point to less than NINE feet, and
provided that such material or coal other than material
to be used in actual building construction, shall not be
permitted to remain in such street for more than three
hours.

SECTION 3. Any such material or coal shall be guarded by
lights if the same remains upon any street after night-
time.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any
provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be
subjected to a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00)
nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), and each day's
continuance of such violation shall constitute a separate
and distinct offense.

ORDINANCE 63 - 7

BEING AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWERAGE SYSTEM ON VAN BUREN STREET, IN THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and imperative that the combined water works and sewerage system of the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, be improved and extended by the construction of a sewerage system from the present terminal on Van Buren Street to the property line of Paul Haverkamp as described below; and

WHEREAS, said Village does not have sufficient funds available for the construction of said water system; and

WHEREAS, Paul Haverkamp, who is the owner of a certain lot described as follows:

Estate 15 Block 21 of Lakewood Lodge Estates, being a Subdivision of part of the West Half of Section 23, Township 42 North, Range 8, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois;

and

WHEREAS, the construction of the proposed sewerage system will in the future become a direct benefit to any person, firm, corporation, or municipal corporation who will connect into or tap into said sewerage system; and

WHEREAS, the said Paul Haverkamp has agreed to pay the entire cost of construction of a sewerage system to run from his property to the existing sewerage system located at approximately a point 330 feet more or less in a southerly direction from his property to the terminal mentioned above, upon the condition that any person, firm, corporation, or municipal corporation be required to pay to the said Paul Haverkamp their respective proportionate share of the cost of said sewerage system before any of them be permitted to connect to or use said system;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That said Paul Haverkamp be and is hereby given permission to construct said sewerage system.

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
ORDINANCE 63 - 8

for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed com-

continues.






BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois:


