A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID FROM A. LAMP CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR YEAR 2012 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH A. LAMP CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, INC.

WEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee have determined that it is desirable and necessary to accept the bid of A. Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. for the Year 2012 Street Improvement Program in the Village of East Dundee as set forth in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee have determined that it is necessary and desirable to authorize and direct the Village President to execute a contract, and any other required documents, for the 2012 Street Improvement Program. The duties and term of the services shall be in accordance with the terms of the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit B.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the corporate authorities do hereby incorporate the foregoing WHEREAS clauses into this ordinance as though fully set forth herein, thereby making the findings as hereinabove set forth.

Section Two. That the Board of Trustees and the President of the Village of East Dundee hereby accept and approve the bid of A. Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc., and the President be and is hereby authorized and directed to sign, and the Village Clerk is directed to attest to the

execution of, the Agreement for Year 2012 Street Improvement Program, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit B, and further authorizing the Village President to execute any other documents necessary for the project.

Section Three. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section Four. Repeal. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

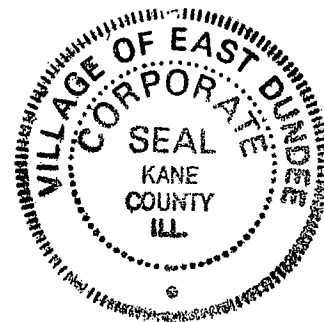

PROPOSAL

TO: VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

1. Proposal of A. Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc.
(Name and Address of Bidder)
1900 Wright Boulevard, Schaumburg, IL 60193
for the improvement, designated Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois "2012 Street Improvement Program", by the construction of hot-mix asphalt resurfacing, patching of distressed pavement areas, removal and construction of combination concrete curb and gutter, thermoplastic pavement marking, and all incidental and appurtenant work necessary to complete the street improvements, in the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, a total distance of approximately 5454 feet (1.033 miles).
2. The plans for the proposed improvement are those prepared by GERALD L. HEINZ & ASSOCIATES, INC, Consulting Engineers, 206 North River Street, East Dundee, Illinois, which plans are designated as Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois "2012 Street Improvement Program" and which cover the work described generally in paragraph 1 above.
3. The specifications herein referred to are the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" adopted January 1, 2012 by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions" adopted January 1, 2012 by the IDOT.
4. The undersigned agrees to accept, as part of the contract, the applicable Special Provisions indicated on the "Check Sheet for Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions" contained in this proposal.
5. The undersigned agrees to complete the work on this project by **November 16, 2012** unless additional time is granted in accordance with the specifications.
6. In submitting this proposal, the undersigned declares that the only persons or parties interested in the proposal as principals are those named herein, and that the proposal is made without collusion with any person, firm or corporation.
7. The undersigned further declares that he has carefully examined the proposal, plans, specifications, form of contract and contract bond included in the specifications, and special provisions and that he has inspected in detail the site of the proposed work, and that he has familiarized himself with all of the local conditions affecting the contract and

the detailed requirements of construction, and understands that in making this proposal, he waives all right to plead any misunderstanding regarding the same.

8. The undersigned further understands and agrees that, if this proposal is accepted, he is to furnish and provide all necessary machinery, tools, apparatus and other means of construction, and to do all of the work, and to furnish all of the materials specified in the contract, except such materials as are to be furnished by the Village in the manner and at the time therein prescribed, and in accordance with the requirements therein set forth.
9. The undersigned declares that he understands that the quantities mentioned are approximate only and that they are subject to increase or decrease; that he will take in full payment therefore the amount and the summation of the actual quantities, as finally determined, multiplied by the unit prices shown in the schedule of prices contained herein.
10. Each pay item should have a unit price and a total price. If no total price is shown or if there is a discrepancy between the product of the unit price multiplied by the quantity, the unit price shall govern. If a unit price is omitted, the total price will be divided by the quantity in order to establish a unit price.
11. A bid will be declared unacceptable if neither a unit price nor a total price is shown.
12. The undersigned further agrees that, if the Village decides to extend or shorten the improvement, or otherwise alter it by extras or deductions, including the elimination of any one or more of the items, as provided in the specifications, he will perform the work as altered, increased or decreased at the contract unit prices.
13. The undersigned further agrees to execute a contract for this work and present the same to the Village within fifteen (15) days after the date of notice of award of the contract to him.
14. The undersigned further agrees that he and his surety will execute and present within fifteen (15) days after the date of notice of the award of contract, a contract bond satisfactory to and in the form prescribed to the Village, in the penal sum of the full amount of the contract, guaranteeing the faithful performance of the work in accordance with the terms of the contract.
15. The undersigned further agrees to begin work no later than ten (10) days after the execution and approval of the contract and contract bond, unless otherwise authorized or

directed by the village, and to prosecute the work in such manner and with sufficient materials, equipment, and labor as will insure its completion within the time limit specified herein, it being understood and agreed that the completion within the time limit is an essential part of the contract.

16. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute the contract and contract bond as required, it is hereby agreed that the Bid Bond or check shall be forfeited to the Village.
17. The undersigned submits herewith this schedule of prices covering the work to be performed under this contract.



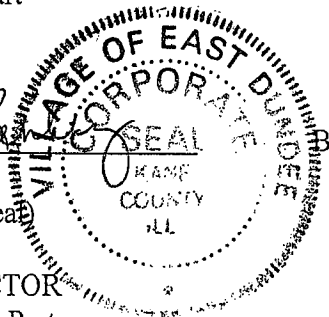



CONTRACT BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, A. LAMP CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, INC., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois and licensed to do business in the State of Illinois, as Principal, and _____, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of _____ with authority to do business in the State of Illinois, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the Village of East Dundee, County of Kane, State of Illinois, in the penal sum of Two Hundred Eighty-two Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-six and 00/100 Dollars (\$282,536.00), lawful money of the United States, well and truly to be paid unto said Village of East Dundee for the payment of which we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly, severally, and firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE FOREGOING OBLIGATIONS IS SUCH that whereas the said Principal has entered into a written contract with the Village of East Dundee acting through the President and Board of Trustees of said Village for construction of the work designated as "2012 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM," which contract is hereby referred to and made a part hereof, as if written herein at length, and whereby the said Principal has promised and agreed to perform said work in accordance with the terms of said contract, and has promised to pay all sums of money due for any labor, materials, apparatus, fixtures or machinery furnished to such Principal for the purpose of performing such work and has further agreed to pay all direct and indirect damages to any person, firm, company, or corporation suffered or sustained on account of the performance of such work during the time thereof and until such work is completed and accepted; and has further agreed that this bond shall inure to the benefit of any person, firm, company or corporation, to whom any money may be due from the Principal, SUBCONTRACTOR or otherwise, for any such labor, materials, apparatus, fixtures or machinery so furnished and that suit may be maintained on such bond by any such person, firm, company or corporation, for the recovery of any such money.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall well and truly perform said work in accordance with the terms of said contract, and shall pay all sums of money due or to become due for any labor, materials, apparatus, fixtures or machinery furnished him for the purpose of constructing said work, and shall commence and complete the work within the time prescribed in said contract, and shall pay and discharge all damages, direct and indirect, that may be suffered or sustained on account of such work during the time of the performance thereof and until the said work shall have been accepted, and shall hold the Village of East Dundee and the President and Board of Trustees and its or his/her agents harmless on account of any such damages, and

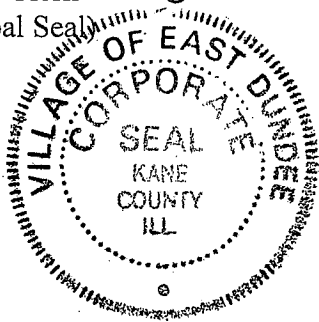

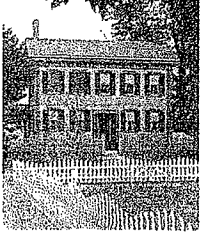

Bids were opened on the 2012 Street Improvement Program yesterday at 10:00 A.M. Five (5) bids were received, ranging from the low bid of \$282,536.00 to a high bid of \$314,316.00. A tabulation of bids is included with this memo for your information. The lowest bid was received from A. Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. of Schaumburg, Illinois. Their bid is approximately 4.42% below our estimate. We would recommend that the Village Board award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, A. Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. by the following action:

1. Move to award the 2012 Street Improvement Program contract to A. Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$282,536.00, provided that the village does not receive any protests within eight (8) days of the bid opening or by September 4, 2012; and
2. Authorize the Village President and Clerk to execute the contract documents and all other forms required during the course of the project.

A. Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. is prequalified with IDOT for this type of work.


