## Residential Recycling and Document Shredding Event

When: Saturday, July 8th, 2017 / 8am – 12noon

Where: 540 S Randall Road, St. Charles, IL 60174



- **Batteries** Alkaline batteries - AA, AAA, C, D, 9V & button batteries; Vehicle - car, truck, motorcycle, power sport
- **Bikes, bike parts, helmets, bike baskets**
- **Books** (any age or condition, hard cover or paperback)
- **Clothes, linens, curtains, paired shoes, hats, ties, belts, purses, backpacks, stuffed animals, plush toys.** Ensure all items are clean, dry and free of odors. We will accept items that are stained or torn. Remove all hangers. Ensure all items are in sealed plastic bags.
- **Confidential Document Shredding:** for residential use (no businesses please).
  - This service provides on-site shredding trucks, where you can watch your documents being shredded if you wish.
  - Quantity limit is 4 boxes (12"width x 16"depth x 10"height) or bags of equivalent size.
  - Staples, paperclips, spiral bindings, file folders without metal, and cellophane envelope windows are fine.
  - Please REMOVE all binder clips, three-ring plastic binders and any larger metal pieces.
  - Please do not bring periodicals, magazines, or other paper that does not contain confidential information. Those materials can go in your household recycling bin.
  - Please note that we will receive documents for shredding only until the trucks are full.
- **Electronics & holiday light-strings (no large household appliances "white goods" or Freon-containing appliances)**
  - **TVs and Monitors have a fee:** \$25 for screens under 21" measured diagonally across the screen or \$35 for 21" and over. Pay with cash or card at event. All other electronic equipment is free to drop off.
- **Fluorescent Lamps** (4 foot tubes) from residential sources only; please no CFLs (most hardware stores take them)
- **Garden Tools:** Small hand tools; Garden tools- shovels, iron rakes, hoes; NO containers, wire cages or fencing please
- **Liquid Latex Paint:** Latex paint is non-toxic but difficult to dispose of because you have to dry it out before placing it in your landfill trash. However, it can be easily recycled into new products with no drying out necessary! PDS will be collecting liquid latex paint for recycling.
  - **Paint has a recycling fee** per container, payable by the resident with cash or check (Latex is \$3.50/gal).
- **Mobility Devices: wheelchairs, crutches**
- **Sewing Machines**
- **Styrofoam blocks, packing peanuts, bubble wrap:** Please bring clean sorted materials. Keep peanuts in a contained bag, separate from the rest of the material.

### What we will NOT be collecting:

No Carpet or Carpet Padding. No Household Hazardous Waste. No Tires or Motor Oil.
