

ORDINANCE NUMBER 07 - 29

ORDINANCE AMENDING ANNUAL FEE SCHEDULE
FOR THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that the Annual Fee Schedule be amended to add a new **Chapter 133, Offenses Against Public Morality**.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the Annual Fee Schedule of the Village of East Dundee is hereby amended by adding a new **Chapter 133, Offenses Against Public Morality** as follows:

CHAPTER 133 B OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC MORALITY

1. Public Intoxication & Public Consumption of Alcoholic Beverage (Sec. 133.001(A)(11)):
Penalty \$100.00
2. Loud Noise: (Sec. 133.001(A)(16)):
Penalty \$100.00
3. Urinating/Defecating in Public: (Sec. 133.001(A)(17)):
Penalty \$100.00

Full fine amount is due and may be payable within thirty (30) days of issue; however, fifty percent (50%) of the fine amount may be paid by mail or at the Village Hall, if done so within fifteen (15) days of issue date.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
