**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XV, LAND USAGE,
CHAPTER 155, SUBDIVISIONS, BY ADDING A NEW
SECTION 155.072(C), CRITERIA FOR REQUIRING A
CONTRIBUTION IN LIEU OF PARK AND SCHOOL
SITES**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that **Title XV**, Land Usage, **Chapter 155**, Subdivisions, be amended by adding a new Section 155.072(C), Criteria for Requiring a Contribution in Lieu of Park and School Sites.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That **Title XV, Land Usage, Chapter 155, Subdivisions**, of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

**§ 155.072 CRITERIA FOR REQUIRING A CONTRIBUTION IN
LIEU OF PARK AND SCHOOL SITES**

(C) Contribution fees paid pursuant to this Chapter shall be restricted to use solely and exclusively for paying the cost of public facilities and capital improvements, or for other improvements at the discretion of the Village Board, within the Village of East Dundee, whether payment is made directly therefore, or as a pledge against bonds, revenue certificates, or other obligations of indebtedness.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
