

ORDINANCE NO. 00 - 17

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF
MUNICIPALLY OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, 65 ILCS 11-76-4, the Village of East Dundee may sell personal property by the vote of a simple majority of the corporate authorities then holding office, when in their opinion, such personal property is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village of East Dundee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said statute, a municipality may, by ordinance authorize the sale of personal property in such manner as they may designate, with or without advertising the sale, or may authorize any municipal officer to convert that personal property in some other form that is useful to the Village or may authorize any municipal officer to convey or turn in any specified article of personal property as part payment on a new purchase of any similar article.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the corporate authorities find the personal property set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" now owned by the Village of East Dundee is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of East Dundee and the best interests of the Village of East Dundee will be served by its sale.

Section Two. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village Administrator, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for sale said personal property and to sell said personal property to the highest bidder or offeror in

response to such ad, or if, in his opinion, no reasonable bids are received for such personal property, to take such further action as he deems necessary to dispose of such personal property.

Section Three. Severability. If any section, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.


Section Four. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Five. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

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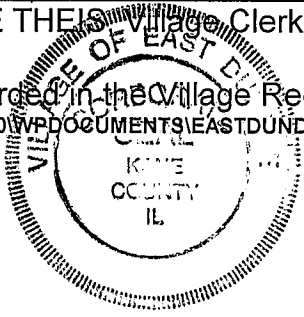
