

Ordinance No. 14-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS, AMENDING THE NOTICE REQUIREMENT TO ALLOW EXTENDED OPEN BURNING

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, the Village regulates outdoor fires and open burning and allows upon certain seasonal conditions and public notice an extended period for the burning of leaves and other landscape waste; and,

WHEREAS, the Village desires to change the public notice to allow such extended periods from being on the agenda to on its website.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane and Cook Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the East Dundee Municipal Code, as amended, be and is hereby amended by amending section 93.08(B)(6) to read as follows:

"(6) If the Village President in his or her discretion determines that due to unusual seasonal conditions it would be appropriate to allow the burning of leaves and other landscape waste material at times other than those specified in this section, the Village President may, by notice posted on the Village's website, extend the above specified time periods for the burning of leaves and other landscape waste material for a period of time not to exceed 30 days prior or subsequent to the time specified in this section."

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.


