

ORDINANCE NUMBER 11- 10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE, CHAPTER 72: PARKING SCHEDULES, SCHEDULE I BY PROHIBITING PARKING ON SUNDAYS ON JOHNSON STREET BETWEEN RIVER STREET AND VAN BUREN THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee has determined that certain roads in the Village are inappropriate for parking on Sundays when residents on Johnson cannot safely exit their driveways because of parishioners parking on Johnson Street; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee have determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that parking of vehicles on the south side of Johnson Street between River Street and Van Buren Street be banned on Sundays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00(noon), in the Village of East Dundee, Counties of Cook and Kane, Illinois.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Title VII; Traffic Code, Chapter 72: Parking Schedules is amended by adding the south side of Johnson Street between River Street and Van Buren Streets in the Village of East Dundee, Cook and Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Title VII, Chapter 72: Parking Schedules

Schedule I: Restricted Parking:

Johnson Street	Between South River Street and South Van Buren Street	No Parking on Sundays on the south side of Johnson between 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 (noon)			

Penalty, see §10.99

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
