

RESOLUTION NUMBER 30 -07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR ROUTE 72 CORRIDOR PLAN BETWEEN THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and desirable for the Village of East Dundee to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement for Route 72 Corridor Plan which will allow for the Illinois Department of Transportation to provide funding to conduct the Route 72 Corridor Plan aimed at optimizing redevelopment opportunities along the corridor and mitigating traffic congestion and enhancing planning and implementation processes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the Village of East Dundee adopts and approves and the Village Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement for Route 72 Corridor Plan which will allow for the Illinois Department of Transportation to provide funding to conduct the Route 72 Corridor Plan aimed at optimizing redevelopment opportunities along the corridor and mitigating traffic congestion and enhancing planning and implementation processes, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section Three. Repeal. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such

section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section Four. Publication. This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
