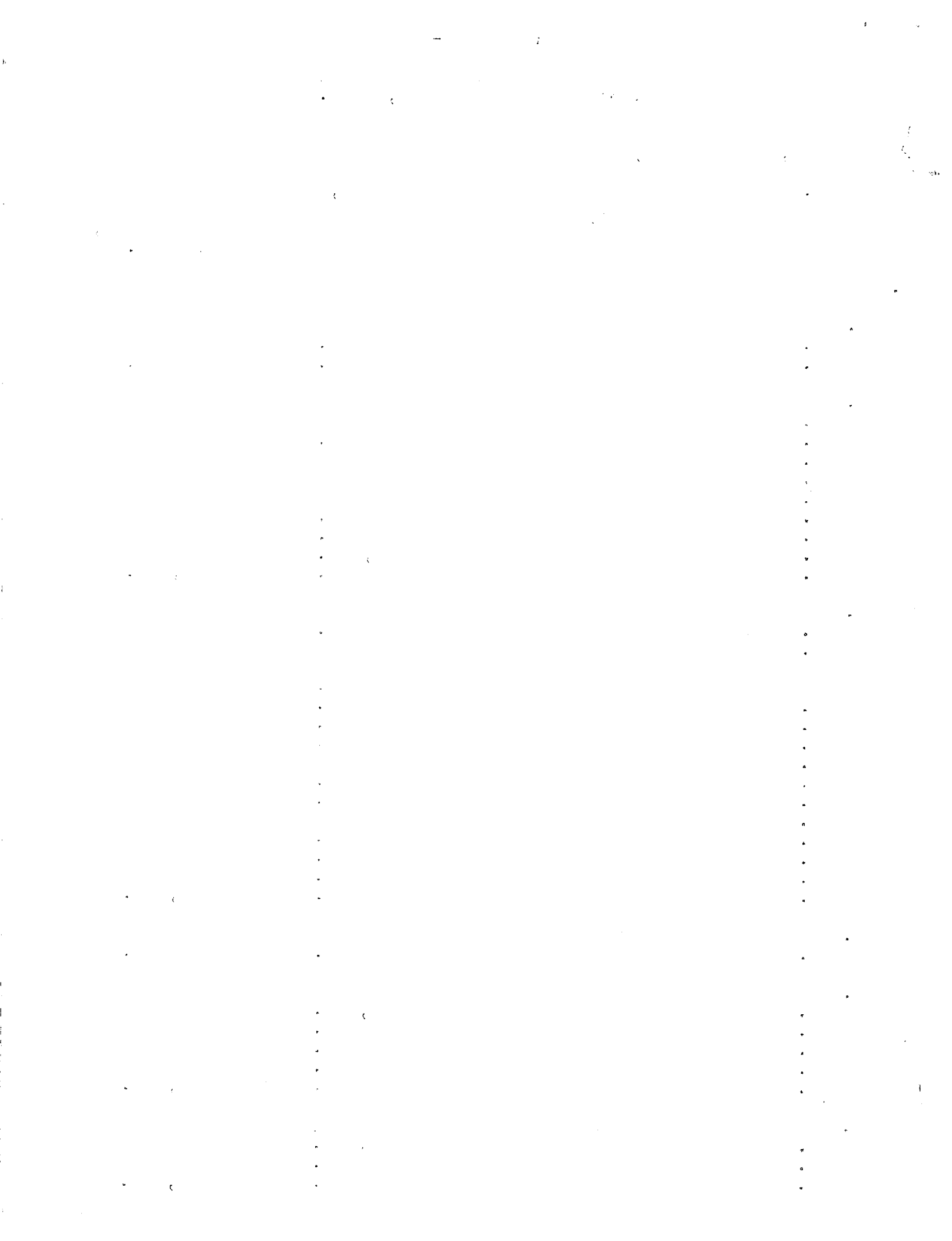

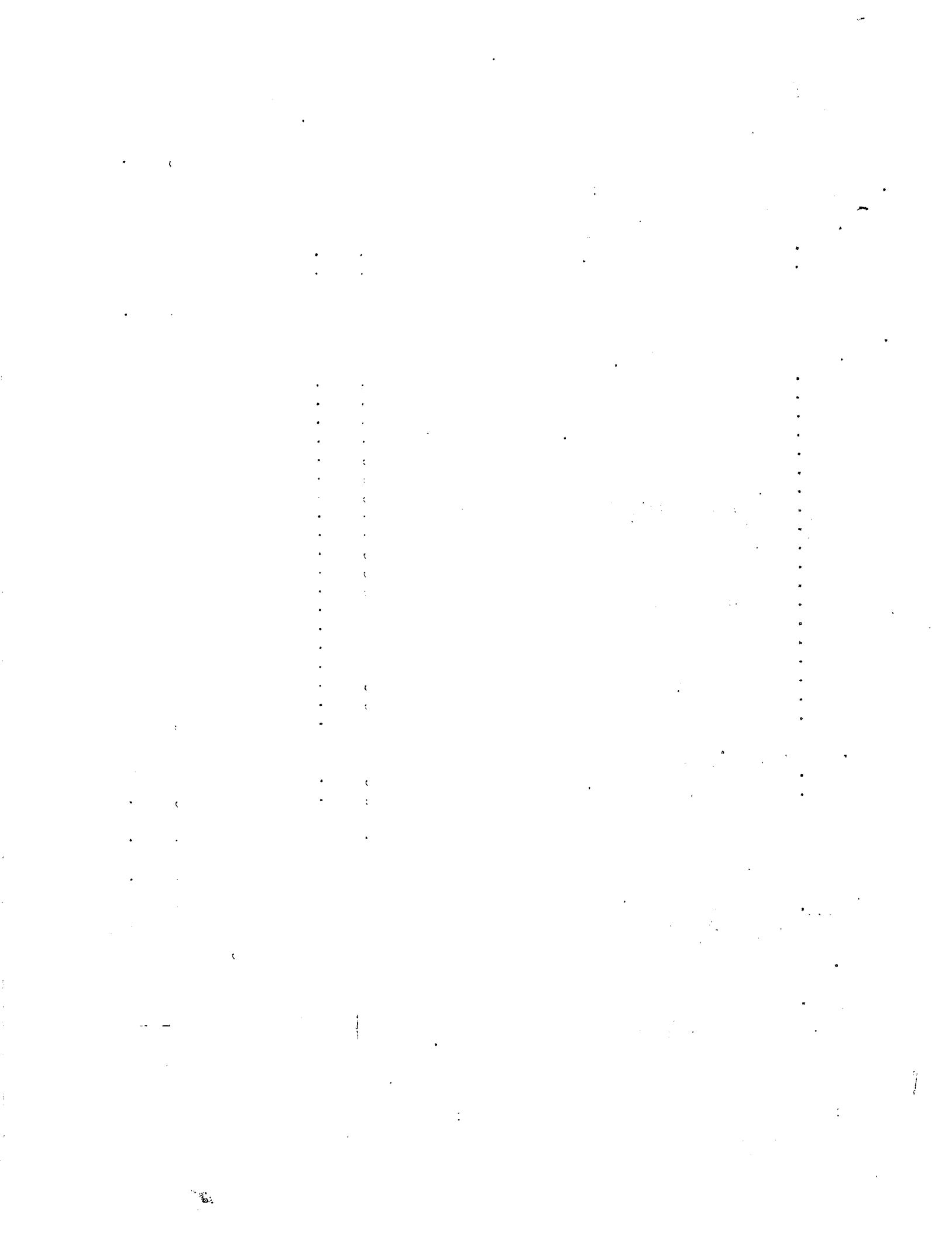

ORDINANCE NO. 65 - 4

being an ordinance annexing certain property lying within the boundaries of the subdivision known as BONNIE DUNDEE TERRACE, into East Dundee, Ill.

WHEREAS, Raymond R. Kramer and Alyce M. Kramer, his wife, have heretofore filed a petition with the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, wherein they have petitioned said board to annex to the Village of East Dundee a certain territory hereinafter described as residential property and subject to their using said territory as such; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of said Village have examined said petition and said territory and find:

1. That said territory is not within the corporate limits of any municipality, but is contiguous with and adjacent to the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois; and

2. That the petitioners are the owners of record of all the land within said territory and that they are all of the electors residing within said territory; and

3. That the description of the territory to be annexed as set forth in the petition is adequate and that the petition to annex said territory to the Village conforms in all respects to the Revised Cities and Villages Act of 1941 as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory; to wit:

That part of Lot 13 in Bonnie Dundee Terrace, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot; thence Southwesterly along the Southerly right of way line of Illinois State Route No. 63, 127 feet to the Northwest corner of said Lot 13; thence South along the West line of said Lot, 203.3 feet; thence Northeasterly along a line which is an extension of the Southerly boundary of Lots 1 to 12 inclusive of said Bonnie Dundee Terrace to the Easterly line of said Lot 13; thence North along said Easterly line to the point of beginning, in the Township of Dundee, Kane County, Illinois,

be and the same is annexed to and made a part of the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, and the whole of said property be annexed and zoned as Residential R-1.

SECTION 2. That the boundary lines of the Village of East Dundee be and they hereby are enlarged and extended to include within the limits of the Village of East Dundee, the premises described in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. That a certified copy of the Ordinance annexing said

territory, together with an accurate map of said annexed territory, be recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Kane County Illinois; and

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and recording as provided by law.

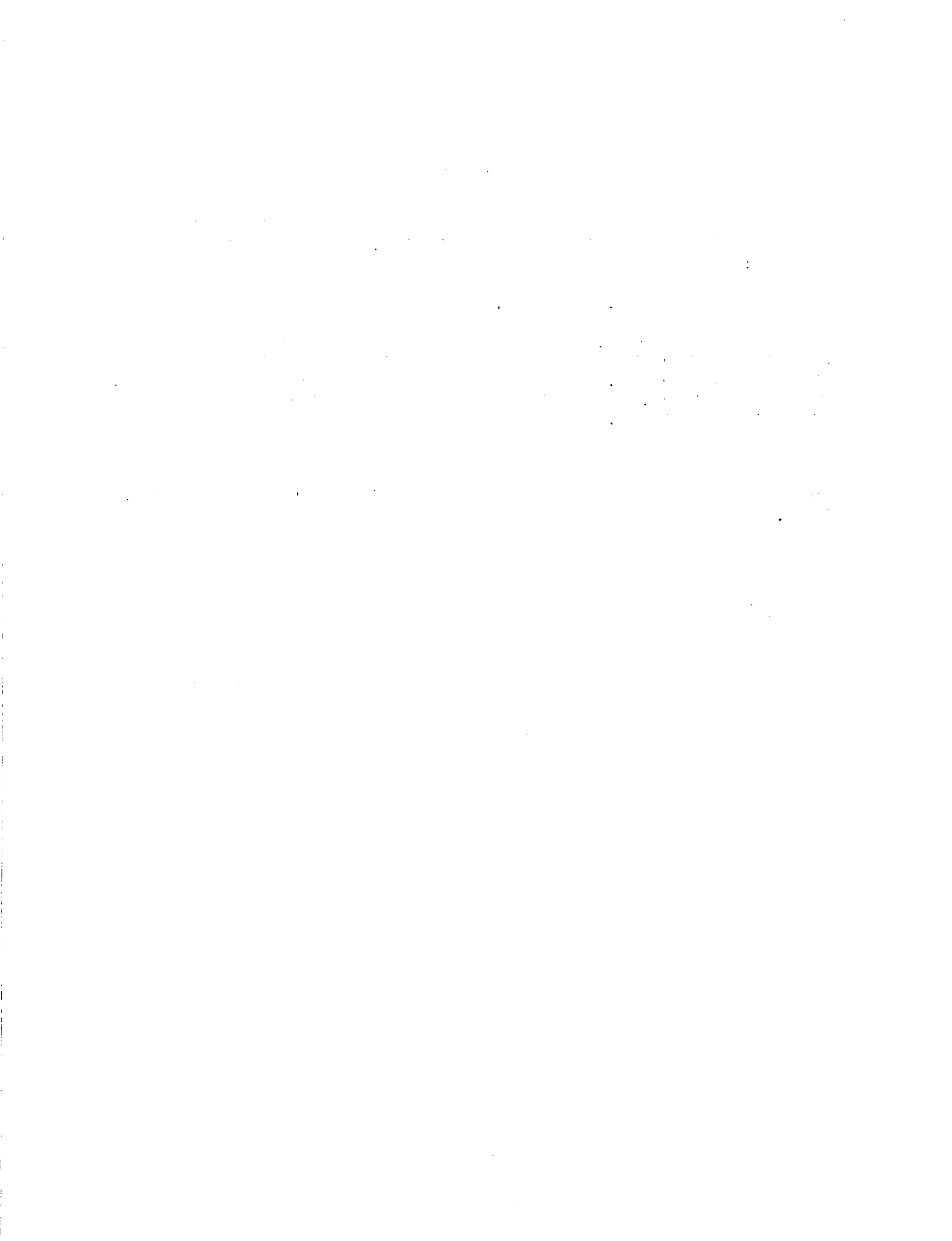

ORDINANCE NO. 65-10

Municipal Leasing Occupation Tax

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1. A tax is hereby imposed upon all persons engaged in the business of renting or leasing tangible personal property to the users thereof at the rate of one-half of one percent of the gross receipts from such renting or leasing made in the course of such business while this ordinance is in effect, in accordance with the provisions of Section 8-11-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section 2. Every person engaged in such business in the Village shall file with the State Department of Revenue the return in the manner as required by Section Five of the "Leasing Occupation Tax Act" as adopted by the 74th General Assembly.

Section 3. At the time such return is filed, there shall be paid to the State Department of Revenue the amount of tax hereby imposed on account of the receipts from renting or leasing tangible personal property during the preceding month.

Section 4. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to transmit to the State Department of Revenue a certified copy of this ordinance not later than five (5) days after the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days of its enactment as provided in Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code and shall be effective from and after the first day of the calendar month next following its publication.
