

RESOLUTION NUMBER 21 - 10

Resolution Authorizing Application for a Case Study Evaluation of Police Department Consolidation with Metropolitan Mayors Caucus between the Villages of West Dundee, Sleepy Hollow and East Dundee

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee strongly believes that in the current economic climate, working together and cooperating for service delivery, particularly for law enforcement, may provide for better, more cost effective law enforcement services to the larger Dundee area ; and,

WHEREAS, through consolidation there may the ability to save dollars and stretch valuable public resources through cooperation and innovation; and,

WHEREAS, the Illinois Constitution provides that units of local government may contract and otherwise associate among themselves and with individuals and corporations in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance pursuant to Article VII, Section 10; and,

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act 5 IL CS 220/1 et seq provides that any one or more public agencies may contract with one another to perform any contract, governmental service activity or undertaking, which any of the public agencies entering into that contract is authorized by law to perform; and,

WHEREAS, currently the three Village continue to benefit from intergovernmental cooperation in the areas of communication and E-911 dispatch and also provide for cooperative utility services; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, has determined it is in its best interest to submit an application for a case study evaluation request for Police Department consolidation with the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus; and,

WHEREAS, the case study evaluation has a cost commitment of \$7500, half of which would be funded by the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus and half by the respective communities; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The Village of East Dundee and its Staff are hereby authorized to execute the application for the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus Police Department Consolidation Case Study Evaluation and any other payments and documentation required to be submitted upon approval of the application by the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
