

ORDINANCE NUMBER 07 - 44

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, ADMINISTRATION,
CHAPTER 31, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES,
GENERAL PROVISIONS, BY ADDING A NEW
SECTION 31.05, ELECTRONIC SERVICES
FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that **Title III, Administration, Chapter 31, Officers and Employees, General Provisions**, be amended by adding a new **Section 31.05, Electronic Services for Elected Officials**.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That **Title III, Administration, Chapter 31, Officers and Employees, General Provisions** of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new **Section 31.05, Electronic Services for Elected Officials**, as follows:

§ 31.05 ELECTRONIC SERVICES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS

Each elected officer of the village shall be given an allowance of \$50.00 per month for the use of electronic devices for village business, including electronic hardware, software and DSL communications. The allowance for electronic devices shall be based upon basic, standard charges, which are reasonable and customary. The allowance shall be paid quarterly at the time of the regular salary payments.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
