

ORDINANCE NUMBER 12 - 76

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, BUSINESS REGULATIONS,
CHAPTER 116: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, §116.05(B), LICENSES, BY
INCREASING THE NUMBER OF CLASS D LICENSES TO TWO**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee have determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, morals and welfare of the citizens of East Dundee for Title XI, Business Regulations, Chapter 116: Alcoholic Beverages, §116.05, to be amended to increase the number of Class D licenses from one (1) to two (2).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Title XI, Business Regulations, Chapter 116, Alcoholic Beverages, §116.05(B), Licenses, is hereby amended to hereafter read as follows:

§ 116.05 LICENSES.

(B) *Number of licenses to be permitted.* The number of licenses issued in all preceding classes shall be as follows, except as modified from time to time by ordinance:

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Section Five. Effective Date. Passed on the 17th day of Sept, 2012, according to the following roll call vote.
