

ORDINANCE NO. 70-1

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: All inoperable motor vehicles, located anywhere in the Village of East Dundee, whether public or private property, are hereby declared to constitute and be a public nuisance.

Section 2: An "Inoperable Motor Vehicle" is hereby defined to be any motor vehicle on which the engine, wheels, steering apparatus, or other essential parts have been removed or altered or do not function properly so that such motor vehicle is incapable of operating properly and safely or on which no current license has been issued for its operation on the public highways by the Secretary of State, providing that (1) vehicles which have been duly licensed and rendered temporarily incapable of being driven under their own motor power because of wreck or damage and are awaiting repair; (2) vehicles temporarily stored in duly licensed commercial garages and storage yards; and (3) vehicles kept inside a fully enclosed garage or storage building, shall not be deemed "inoperable Motor vehicles" within the meaning of this section.

Section 3: Any person, firm, or corporation convicted of violating this Section shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$200.00 for any first offense. Upon any second or subsequent offense shall be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$200.00.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its passage and publication.

LEVY ORDINANCE

Being an Ordinance providing for the levy and assessment of taxes for the fiscal year 1970 - 1971 for the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that

Section 1 A tax for the following sums of money or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, is hereby levied for the purposes specified in Appropriation Ordinance No. against all taxable property in the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of May, 1970 and ending on the 30th day of April, 1971.

AN ORDINANCE providing for the creation and participation by the (Village of East Dundee) or (City of _____), Illinois, in a local Mass Transit District.

WHEREAS the Local Mass Transit District Act, approved July 21, 1959, as amended by House Bill No. 815 enacted by the Seventy-fifth General Assembly of the State of Illinois, effective June 29, 1967, provides for the creation of a local mass transit district for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, owning, operating and maintaining mass transit facilities for public service or subsidizing the operation thereof; and

WHEREAS it is anticipated that the municipalities of Bensenville, Itasca, Roselle, Wood Dale, Elgin, Bartlett, Elmwood Park, Franklin Park, South Elgin, East Dundee, Schaumburg, Streamwood, Elk Grove Village and River Grove, or some combination of said municipalities, or others, shall by ordinance create and participate in the creation of a local mass transit district to be called the Northwest Suburban Mass Transit District, the territorial limits of which shall be coexistent with the territorial limits of all the participating municipalities; and

WHEREAS it is deemed to be in the public interest and for the benefit of the inhabitants of the (Village of East Dundee) or (City of _____), Illinois, that the (Village of East Dundee) or (City of _____) participate in the creation of said district; and

WHEREAS the powers of the said District shall repose in and be exercised by a Board of Trustees as provided by said Local Mass Transit District Act, as amended, one of whom shall be appointed by the corporate authority of each of the municipalities participating therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the (President and Board of Trustees) or (City Council) or (Council) of the (Village of East Dundee) or (City of _____), Kane County, Illinois, THAT:

Section One: Creation

The (Village of East Dundee) or (City of _____) hereby creates and participates in the creation of the Northwest Suburban Mass Transit District.

Section Two: Appointment of Trustee

Lois Geister is hereby appointed to the Board of Trustees of the Northwest Suburban Mass Transit District on behalf of the (Village of East Dundee) or (City of _____).

Section Three: Recording

A certified copy of this ordinance, together with a certified copy of each ordinance adopted by each participating municipality creating the District, and the names of the persons as appointed Trustees by each of said participating municipalities shall be filed by the Clerks of the several participating municipalities with the County Clerk (s) of Kane Counties, Illinois, for recording as Certificate of Incorporation.

Section Four: Effective Date

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
