

ORDINANCE NUMBER 00 - 05

**ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF
A PORTION OF GUTH STREET TO
GREENWOOD AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee have closed to through traffic a portion of Guth Street; and

WHEREAS, such closure has resulted in confusion concerning the name of a portion of such area of Guth Street adjacent to Greenwood Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-80-19 have the authority to change the name of any street, avenue, alley, or other public place.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That portion of Guth Street north of the permanent closure gate located on said Guth Street be renamed as Greenwood Avenue.

Section Two. Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-80-20 this name change shall not be effective until 30 days after the election authorities having jurisdiction in the Village of East Dundee and the post office branch serving the Village of East Dundee have been notified by the corporate authorities of such change by certified or registered mail.

Section Three. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the

invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.


Section Four. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Five. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


