

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 33 - 00**

**RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE COMPLETION OF  
STATE ROUTE 72 FROM STATE ROUTE 25 TO  
RANDALL ROAD IN DUNDEE TOWNSHIP**

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee have determined that it is advisable, necessary, and in the public interest that the Village endorse the local bridge study for Dundee Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Village Board urges the County Transportation Committee to support the urgent prioritization of the completion of the widening of Illinois State Route 72 from East Dundee through to Randall Road, in Kane County, Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village is in support of and believes it is essential that State Route 72 from State Route 25 to State Route 68 be widened in the first phase of this project.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One.** That Village of East Dundee hereby supports the completion of the widening of State Route 72 from State Route 25 through to Randall Road in Dundee Township. (1) The current reconfigured four (4) lane bridge from East to West Dundee has engendered a perception that State Route 72 is a four lane through to Randall Road; (2) The perception that the four lanes exist as a viable traffic corridor to the west attracts and increases drive time, consumes fuel, and congests the downtown areas of the Villages; (3) It is essential that the initial effort be completed to provide the traffic a corridor from east to west to minimize travel time, reduce fuel consumption, reduce congestion, and meet the

demand that current and future residents of Dundee Township by expanding the existing arterials in coordination with local feeder systems and development.

**Section Two. Severability.** If any section, paragraph, or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

**Section Three. Repeal.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

**Section Four. Publication.** This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


