

ORDINANCE NUMBER 08 - 62

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII, CHAPTER 71,
SCHEDULE VI, RESTRICTIONS AT INTERSECTIONS
EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of East Dundee that Title VII, Traffic Code, Chapter 71, Schedule 6, be amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Title VII, Traffic Code, Chapter 71, Schedule 6, be amended to add to the list of restricted turn intersections therein described, the following:

Route 25	Intersection with State Route 72	"left on green arrow only"	Southbound
Route 25	Intersection with State Route 72	"left on green arrow only"	Northbound
Route 25	Intersection with Route 68	"left turn signal" sign	Southbound
Route 25	Intersection with Route 68	"left turn signal" sign	Northbound
Route 68	Intersection with Route 25	"left on green arrow only"	Northbound
Route 68	Intersection with Route 25	"left on green arrow only"	Eastbound
Route 68	Intersection with Route 72	"right turn only"	

Section Two. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval and publication as required by law. That, except as amended herein, the original Budget Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the corporate authorities then holding office, the "ayes" and "nays" being called at a regular meeting of said Board of Trustees.

Section Four. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Five. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Six. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
