

ORDINANCE NUMBER 01 - 01

**AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 36, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES,
SECTION 36.05(b), NUMBER OF LICENSES TO BE ISSUED,
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE
VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee as a non-home rule unit has been granted such statutory powers pursuant to the Illinois Constitution either expressly or as may be impliedly necessary to the accomplishment of the intent of the duties expressly conferred on it by law; and

WHEREAS, the Alcoholic Beverages Code of the Village of East Dundee, Chapter 36, Section 36.05, **Licenses, (b), Number of Licenses to be Issued** provides therein that under the A-1 classification, one (1) license may be issued; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commission of the Village of East Dundee after due consideration has recommended that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and public welfare of the residents of the Village to increase the number of Class A-1 licenses to two (2) licenses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Chapter 36, **Alcoholic Beverages**, Section 36.05, **Licenses, (b) Number of Licenses to be Issued** be amended to change the number of licenses permitted in the A-1 classification to two (2) licenses.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.



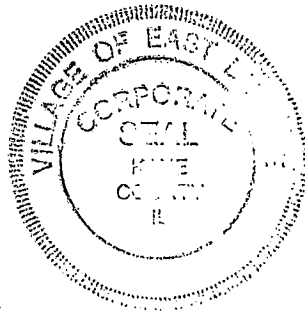
