

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2000 - 01

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISCONNECTION  
OF CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM THE  
VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS,  
COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE SCHOLER PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, a written Petition signed by the legal owner of record of all land within the territory hereinafter described and commonly known as 243 Bramer Street, East Dundee, Illinois, which is legally described below, has been filed with the Village Clerk of the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, requesting that said territory be disconnected from the Village of East Dundee; and

**WHEREAS**, the Petition was signed by all of the Owners and electors residing within the said territory; and

**WHEREAS**, the territory is within the corporate limits of the Village of East Dundee and is contiguous to the corporate limits of the Village of Carpentersville; and

**WHEREAS**, the territory does not exceed 160 acres and is legally described as follows:

That part of Lot 7 within the Village of East Dundee, in Block 5 of Mary E. Carpenter's Addition to Carpentersville and East Dundee, in the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois.

**WHEREAS**, all petitions, documents and other necessary legal requirements are in full compliance with the statutes of the State of Illinois, specifically Section 7-1-24 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/7-1-24; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to statute this ordinance shall effect immediately upon its passage and approval by a majority of the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section One.** That the territory bearing the legal description set forth above is hereby disconnected from the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois.

**Section Two.** That this Ordinance take effect, pursuant to statute, only upon the annexation of such territory to the Village of Carpentersville.

**Section Three. Severability.** If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

**Section Four. Repeal.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

**Section Five. Publication.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval as provided by law.


