

ORDINANCE NUMBER 06 - 48

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XV, LAND USAGE,
CHAPTER 157, ZONING, SECTION 157.003,
RULES AND DEFINITIONS, SUBSECTION (B)**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that Title XV, ZONING, Chapter 157, ZONING, Section 157.003(B) be amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Title XV, ZONING, Chapter 157, ZONING, Section 157.003(B) of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to include the following:

§ 157.003 RULES AND DEFINITIONS.

(B) For the purpose of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

FIREARM. Any device, by whatever name known, which is designed to expel a projectile or projectiles by the action of an explosion, expansion of gas or escape of gas, excluding, however:

(a) Any pneumatic gun, spring gun, paint ball or B-B gun which either expels a single globular projectile not exceeding eighteen one-hundredths in diameter or breakable paint balls containing washable marking colors;

(b) Any device used exclusively for signaling or safety and required or recommended by the United States Coast Guard or the Interstate Commerce Commission;

(c) Any device used exclusively for the firing of stud cartridges, explosive rivets or similar industrial ammunition;

(d) An antique firearm (other than an assault weapon) which although designed as a weapon, the Department of State Police finds by reasons of the date of its manufacture, value, design, or other characteristic is primarily a collector's item and is not likely to be used as a weapon.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

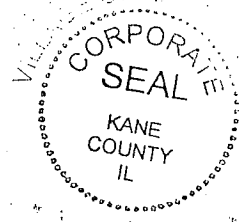
