**ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 09-18,  
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LOAN  
AGREEMENT FOR THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE TO  
BORROW FUNDS FROM THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY  
LOAN PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of East Dundee enacted Ordinance 09-18 authorizing the loan agreement for the Village of East Dundee to borrow funds from the public water supply loan program; and

**WHEREAS**, due to circumstances necessitating new additional ordinances and resolutions for the loan agreement from the public water supply loan program, Ordinance 09-18 is no longer necessary or desirable;

**WHEREAS**, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Illinois desire to repeal Ordinance 09-18 in its entirety;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One.** That Ordinance 09-18 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Section Two. Severability.** If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

**Section Three. Repeal.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

**Section Four. Publication.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
