

ORDINANCE NUMBER 12 - 27

**ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ALONG ROUTE 72
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois acting by and through its Department of Transportation is desirous of improving Route 72 between Rock Road and Beverly Road in the Village of East Dundee; and

WHEREAS, a portion of this project runs through the Village of East Dundee between Beverly Road and Rock Road; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and ensure safety to the motoring public, the Village of East Dundee determines that the parking along Route 72 shall be prohibited.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That parking shall not be permitted along Route 72 from Rock Road to Beverly Road within the Village limits of the Village of East Dundee.

Section Two. That the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee will prohibit future parking at such locations on or immediately adjacent to Route 72 as may be determined and directed by the State of Illinois to be necessary to ensure the free flow of traffic and safety to the motoring public.

Section Three. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attach a copy of this Ordinance to the Agreement dated June 18th, 2012 by and between the State of Illinois and the Village of East Dundee.

Section Four. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Five. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Six. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Section Seven. Effective Date. Passed on the 18th day of June, 2012, according to the following roll call vote.
