

ORDINANCE NUMBER 11 - 34

**ORDINANCE GRANTING A VARIANCE FOR THE
PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS 460 DUNDEE
AVENUE, EAST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee have determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that Petitions a variance to Section 156.04(C)(1)(b) to allow for a sign that is 220sq ft.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission (hereinafter the "Commission") of the Village of East Dundee, pursuant to notice and pursuant to the East Dundee Code of Ordinances, held a hearing on July 14, 2011, on Petition No. 11-07-01; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said hearing, the Commission approved, the variance for the property commonly known as 460 Dundee Avenue, Village of East Dundee, Illinois, by a vote of 8 ayes, 0 nays, 0 present and 1 absent.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE AND COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That a variance for the property commonly known as 460 Dundee Avenue, East Dundee, Illinois, requested pursuant to Petition No. 11-07-01 is hereby granted to allow for a sign that is 220sq ft, but the total signage for the building still be under 10% of the total frontage. Hereby, the requests a variance, to allow for 220sq ft signage or no more than 10% of the front building façade for Safari Daycare located at 460 Dundee Avenue, East Dundee, Illinois 60118, be granted.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
