

Resolution No. 05-14

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR THE
FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION CHANGE OF BONNIE DUNDEE ROAD AS A
FEDERAL AID URBAN MINOR ARTERIAL ROUTE**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "Village") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Carpentersville has petitioned the Kane-Kendall Council of Mayors to classify Northlake Parkway as a Federal Aid Urban (FAU) minor arterial; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Carpentersville request requires that Bonnie Dundee Road also be classified as a FAU minor arterial because FAU routes must start and end at other FAU routes; and,

WHEREAS, the classification of Bonnie Dundee Road in the Village will qualify that street for federal funding assistance for maintenance and reconstruction which has assisted the Village in funding improvements of the other FAU routes in the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to prepare and execute a letter to the Kane-Kendall Council of Mayors supporting the functional classification change of Bonnie Dundee Road in the Village as a Federal Aid Urban minor arterial route.

Section 2: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.

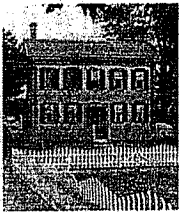

We have been contacted by Jennifer Becker and Patrick Knapp, Regional Planning Liaisons with the Kane Kendall Council of Mayors (KKCOM), notifying us that the Village of Carpentersville has petitioned the council to classify Northlake Parkway as a Federal Aid Urban (FAU) Minor Arterial. Bonnie Dundee Road was added to Carpentersville's request because FAU routes need to start and stop at other FAU routes.

The KKCOM staff and municipal recommendations were approved by the Transportation Policy Committee which will be presented to the full council for approval of the recommendations. If approved, the request then goes to the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and ultimately to the Federal Highway Administration for approval.

Streets that are designated FAU routes qualify for federal funding assistance for maintenance and reconstruction. The village has several streets that are FAU routes and has benefited from federal participation, most recently with the Van Buren Street Reconstruction project. If funding is requested, minimum design standards need to be met, but there are no design requirements if improvements are fully funded by the village.

The notification also included a request that the village send a letter of support to be included in the packet to IDOT. We recommend that the village support the KKCOM request to classify Bonnie Dundee Road as an FAU route to give the village the opportunity to maintain or reconstruct this street with the benefit of federal funding assistance.

Dear Gerry,

The Kane/Kendall Council of Mayors staff began the process of reviewing all roadway functional classes last year in Kane and Kendall counties with the goal of developing a comprehensive list to process through the Council of Mayors and ultimately to IDOT and FHWA for review and approval. KKCOM reached out to municipalities last fall with staff recommendations and received feedback from a number of municipalities. Staff and municipal recommendations were then presented at the January 16th Transportation Policy Committee Meeting where our recommendations were unanimously approved by the committee. The Village of Carpentersville recommended road segments that went through the Village of East Dundee. Below is a table of the segments:

Next steps: KKCOM staff will now be presenting the full list to the KKCOM Full Council Meeting on February 18th for approval. Once the Full Council approves the recommended routes, KKCOM staff will submit the full recommendation packet to IDOT and ultimately the FHWA for approval.

What we need from you: In the meantime, we will need your municipality to submit a letter of support for the road segment (**Bonnie Dundee Rd**) listed above. The support letter is required and will become part of the packet KCOM staff will present to IDOT. We would like to receive all letters by **February 21st** so we can start working on the FAU submittal to IDOT. Please submit all letters of support to Regional Planning Liaisons Jennifer Becker and Patrick Knapp.

Included with this letter is a map of your community with the existing and recommended functional classifications, as well as a letter of support template you can choose to use.

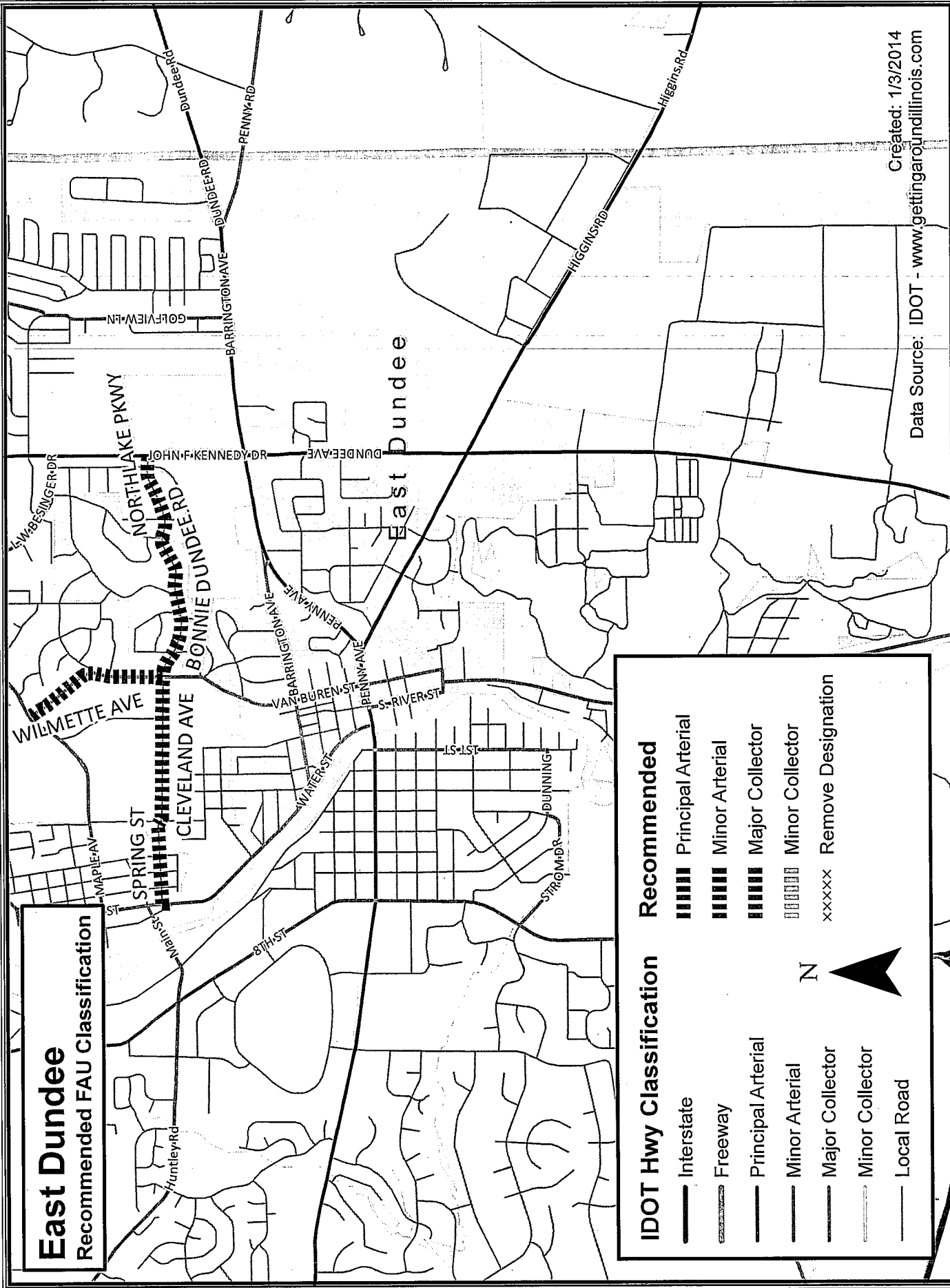
