

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 34 - 00**

**RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE LOCAL BRIDGE  
STUDY FOR DUNDEE TOWNSHIP**

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the Village of East Dundee have determined that it is advisable, necessary, and in the public interest that the Village endorse the local bridge study for Dundee Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Village Board urges the County Transportation Committee to support the local bridge study and sittings for east/west traffic planning coordinated with local development, open space, and traffic distribution for Dundee Township in Kane County, Illinois.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One.** That Village of East Dundee hereby supports the study of the local bridge concept and siting for Dundee Township. (1) The current east/west traffic flow is focused on two corridors only: Main Street, Carpentersville, and State Route 72, East/West Dundee; (2) The bridge capacities are inadequate for the current and projected development for the area and impede the regional flow of traffic; (3) It is essential that the east/west traffic corridors from east to west to minimize travel time, reduce fuel consumption, reduce congestion, and meet the demand that current and future residents of Dundee Township by expanding the existing bridge system in coordination with local feeder systems and development; (4) Future bridge sittings must be coordinated with planned open space, development, and use to minimize impacts upon existing and future community structure.

**Section Two.** Because State Route 72 between State Route 25 and State Route 68 is currently constricted to only two through lanes, the Village of East Dundee believes that priority should be given to the widening of this section.

**Section Three. Severability.** If any section, paragraph, or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

**Section Four. Repeal.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

**Section Five. Publication.** This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


