ORDINANCE 67-7

BEING AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE "KANE COUNTY AREA POLICE EMERGENCY CALL-UP PLAN".

WHEREAS, a serious need exists in Kane County for a uniform, workable plan familiar to, and utilized by, all police agencies in said County in regard to emergency assistance to and from all law enforcement agencies operating in said County, and

WHEREAS, in this day of civil disturbances, disregard of the law, immorality, and vandalism, the police agencies operating in said Kane County, both large and small, must be concerned with the effective law enforcement in the entire County, since the magnitude and the number of enforcement problems can many times no longer be handled by a single police agency, nor can the general citizenry be counted on as volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the Kane County Chief's and Sheriff's Association has drafted an emergency call-up plan known as the "Kane County Area Police Emergency Call-up Plan", a true copy of which is attached to and made a part of this resolution, and said Association has urged all communities and police agencies in the County to participate in said Plan; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Council it is in the general public interest of the People of the Village of East Dundee and necessary in order to more adequately preserve the public health and safety, that the Village of East Dundee participate in the "Kane County Area Police Emergency Call-up-Plan".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE POLICE DEPARTMENT is hereby authorized and directed to participate in the "Kane County Area Police Emergency Call-up Plan", pursuant to the provisions set forth for the operation of said plan as it is now in effect, or as it is amended from time to time.

Section 2. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Secretary of the Kane County Chief's and Sheriff's Police Association as acknowledgement that the VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE POLICE DEPARTMENT will participate in said Emergency Call-up Plan.

Section 3. That by the adoption of this Ordinance, the VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE expressly assumes the responsibility for members of its police force acting pursuant to said Emergency Call-up Plan, both as to indemnification of said police officers as provided for by Chapter 24, Illinois Revised Statutes, Section 1-4-6, and as to personal benefits to said police officers, all to the same extent

that they are protected, insured, indemnified, and otherwise provided for by the statutes of the State of Illinois and the ordinances of the VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, when acting solely within the corporate limits of the VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE; said participation in the Emergency Call-up Plan being hereby designated and defined to be included in the duties of the VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

Section 4. That the Ordinance shall be in full force and effect until rescinded by the VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE and written notification thereof given to the Secretary of the Kane County Chief's and Sheriff's Police Association.

ORDINANCE 67- 1

Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. A tax is hereby imposed upon all persons engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property at retail in this village at the rate of three-quarters of one per cent of the gross receipts from such sales made in the course of such business while this ordinance is in effect, in accordance with the provisions of Section 8-11-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section 2. Every such person engaged in such business in the village shall file on or before the last day of each calendar month, the report to the State Department of Revenue required by Section Three of "An Act in Relation to a Tax upon Persons Engaged in the Business of Selling Tangible Personal Property to Purchasers for Use or Consumption" approved June 28, 1933, as amended.

Section 3. At the time such report is filed, there shall be paid to the State Department of Revenue the amount of tax hereby imposed on account of the receipts from sales of tangible personal property during the preceding month.

Section 4. The village clerk is hereby directed to transmit to the State Department of Revenue a certified copy of this ordinance not later than five (5) days after the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days of its enactment as provided in Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code and shall be effective from and after the first day of the calendar month next following the expiration of the ten (10) day publication period.

This ordinance shall take effect on the first day of August, 1967.

Municipal Service Occupation Tax

Section 2. Every supplier or serviceman required to account for Municipal Service Occupation Tax for the benefit of this municipality shall file, on or before the last day of each calendar month, the report to the State Department of Revenue required by Section Nine of the Service Occupation Tax Act.

Section 3. At the time such report is filed, there shall be paid to the State Department of Revenue the amount of tax hereby imposed.

Section 4. The village clerk is hereby directed to transmit to the State Department of Revenue a certified copy of this ordinance not later than five (5) days after the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days of its enactment as provided in Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code and shall be effective from and after the first day of the calendar month next following the expiration of the ten (10) day publication period.

Being an ORDINANCE DELINEATING THE PRESCRIBED PATTERN OF PARKING ALONG ILLINOIS ROUTES 72 AND ILLINOIS ROUTE 25.

Being an ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONNECTION OF SANITARY OR INDUSTRIAL WASTE SEWERS TO STORM WATER DRAINAGE SYSTEMS.

Be it ordained by the PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to connect or cause to be connected, any drain carrying, or to carry, any toilet, sink, basement, septic tank, cesspool, industrial waste, or any fixture or device discharging polluting substances, to any storm water drainage system within the Village Limits of East Dundee, Illinois.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) nor more than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed for each and every day during which a violation continues or exists.

A RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL OF THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE joint Village-State Improvement along F.A.S. Route 106 (Illinois Route 25), State Section 56 (W&RS-1), extending from south of Illinois 63 to south of Illinois Route 72 in the Village of East Dundee, Kane County, Illinois.

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois acting through the Department of Public Works and Buildings, has heretofore submitted to the Village of East Dundee a set of plans, delineating the construction details of a joint improvement of F.A.S. Route 106 (Illinois Route 25) from south of Illinois Route 63, southerly to approximately 0.37 mile south of Illinois Route 72, a distance of approximately 0.91 mile, and

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee has examined the said plans and specifications, and
