

ORDINANCE NUMBER 06 - 02

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TEXT OF TITLE III,
ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 31, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES,
SECTION 31.16, VILLAGE CLERK, OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that Title III, **Administration**, Chapter 31, **Officers and Employees**, Section 31.16, **Village Clerk**, subsections (A) and (G), be amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Title III, **Administration, Chapter 31, Officers and Employees**, of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by deleting subsections (A) and (G) of Section 31.16 in their entirety and inserting the following in lieu thereof:

§ 31.16 VILLAGE CLERK

- (A) *Election.* The Village Clerk shall be elected to serve for a four-year term and until his or her successor is elected and qualified as provided by statute. If for any reason a Village Clerk is not elected and a vacancy then exists in the office, the Village Clerk, who must be a resident of the Village, shall be appointed by the President of the Village with the advise and consent of at least four of the Board of Trustees then holding office for a term as set by the Board until his or her successor is elected and qualified as provided by statute.

(G) *Salary.* The Village Clerk shall be compensated at \$150.00/per meeting or in an amount as set by the Village Board.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
