

ORDINANCE NUMBER 07 - 32

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XIII, GENERAL OFFENSES,
CHAPTER 133, OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC MORALITY,
SECTION 133.001, DISORDERLY CONDUCT**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that **Title XIII, General Offenses, Chapter 133, Offenses Against Public Morality, Section 133.001, Disorderly Conduct** be amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That **Title XIII, General Offenses, Chapter 133, Offenses Against Public Morality, Section 133.001, Disorderly Conduct** of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

' 133.001 DISORDERLY CONDUCT

(A) A person commits disorderly conduct when he knowingly:

(16) Disturbs the peace or quiet or any other person by creating excessive noise on his or her own or on any property. Excessive noise shall include, but not by way of limitation, any of the following:

(a) Loud playing of phonographs, radios, television sets, music machines, or musical instruments.

(b) Vehicles or gasoline motors without mufflers or the unnecessary use of horns on vehicles.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
