

ORDINANCE NUMBER 11 - 17

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF
JURISDICTION OF THE FRONTAGE ROADS (FROM IL ROUTE 68
TO VISTA LANE & FROM IL ROUTE 25 TO BALMORAL DRIVE)
FROM IDOT TO THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and desirable for the Village of East Dundee to authorize the Ordinance of the Transfer of Jurisdiction Frontage Road (from IL Route 82 to Vista Lane) that is approximately 650 feet in length is from IDOT to Village of East Dundee as depicted on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and desirable for the Village of East Dundee to authorize the Ordinance of the Transfer of Jurisdiction Frontage Road (from IL Route 25 to Balmoral Drive) that is approximately 650 feet in length is from IDOT to Village of East Dundee as depicted on the map attached hereto as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is willing to assume jurisdiction of a segment of Frontage Road (from IL Route 68 to Vista Lane) and a segment of Frontage Road (from IL Route 25 to Balmoral Drive) described above and as depicted on the aforesaid Exhibits A and B; and

WHEREAS, the Village has prepared an Intergovernmental Agreement/Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer providing for the transfer of the aforementioned segments of Frontage Roads (from IL Route 68 to Vista Lane and from IL route 25 to Balmoral Drive), to the Village, as set forth in the documents attached hereto as Exhibit C&D and the said Agreement(s) must be executed before the transfer of jurisdiction can occur; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the residents of the Village of East Dundee to accept jurisdiction of the Frontage Roads into the Village of East Dundee, and to accept said roads into the Village street system.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That the segment of Frontage Road (from IL Route 68 to Vista Lane), in its entirety, that is approximately 650 feet in length is hereby deleted from IDOT.

Section Two. That the segment of Frontage Road (from IL Route 25 to Balmoral Drive), in its entirety, that is approximately 650 feet in length is hereby deleted from IDOT.

Section Three. That the segment of Frontage Road (from IL Route 68 to Vista Lane), in its entirety, that is approximately 650 feet in length is accepted and jurisdiction is hereby transferred to the Village of East Dundee to be part of, and incorporated into, the Village of East Dundee street system.

Section Four. That the segment of Frontage Road (from IL Route 25 to Balmoral Drive) in its entirety, that is approximately 650 feet in length is accepted and jurisdiction is hereby transferred to the Village of East Dundee to be part of, and incorporated into, the Village of East Dundee street system.

Section Five. The Village of East Dundee hereby authorizes and approves the Village of East Dundee to execute the two Local Agency Agreements for Jurisdictional Transfer and any other such documents which may be necessary to affect said transfers.

Section Six. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Seven. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Eight. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
