

Ordinance No. 13-56

**AN ORDINANCE REFERENCING THE PARKING PENALTIES CONTAINED
IN THE ANNUAL FEE SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-208(a)1 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208(a)1) authorizes a municipality to regulate the standing or parking of vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee, Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Chapter 72 of the Code of the Village of East Dundee be and is hereby amended by adding the following:

"72.01 PENALTY

- A. Any owner or operator, who is accused of a violation of this Chapter, may settle and compromise that claim by paying the amount within the timeframe as provided in the Annual Fee Schedule, as amended.
- B. If the person accused of the violation does not settle the claim, the compliant shall be subject to administrative adjudication pursuant to Chapter 36 and the person shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 10.99.
- C. Payments received by mail shall be credited as paid on the date received by the Village.
- D. Whenever any vehicle shall have been parked in violation of any regulation of this Chapter, the person in whose name such vehicle is registered shall be prima facie responsible for such violation."

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
