**RESOLUTION FOR PARTICIPATION IN A 2010 CENSUS
PARTNERSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and desirable for the Village of East Dundee, which fosters intergovernmental cooperation within the region, to authorize and approve a Resolution Supporting a 2010 Census Partnership.

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee will appoint a Complete Count Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee will utilize local media outlets to inform, motivate, and educate residents on the importance of their participation in the 2010 Census;

WHEREAS, the Village will create census awareness messages to inform constituents groups of the census on essential programs and services; and

WHEREAS, To encourage area businesses to promote the census by displaying census messages in their business materials and to sponsor Census 2010 activities, as well as, disseminate materials about census job opportunities to all segments of the community;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of East Dundee supports the 2010 Census and pledges its assistance to enhance the 2010 Census efforts.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the Village of East Dundee respectfully encourages its member municipalities, townships and other local governments and organizations to support the 2010 Census Partnership as well as to pledge their assistance to enhance the 2010 Census efforts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section Three. Repeal. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section Four. Publication. This resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


